DIRECTIONS

FROM HARPERS FERRY Take Route 340 West toward Charles Town. Continue on Route 340 and take Route 230 (toward Shepherdstown) for approximately 2 miles; Turn left onto Route 22 (Job Corps Road); entrance to Sam Michael's Park is 1/2 mile on left.

FROM LEESBURG, VA (Approximately 25 miles) Take Route 7 West to Route 9 West toward Charles Town; Stay on Route 9 to VA Route 671; Turn right onto VA 671; Stay on VA 671 until the junction of 671 and Route 340; Turn left onto Route 340 and continue towards Charles Town (do not exit into Harpers Ferry) to Route 230 (toward Shepherdstown); Turn right onto Route 230 & stay on for approximately 2 miles; Turn left onto Route 22 (Job Corps Road); Entrance to Sam Michael's Park is 1/2 mile on left.

FROM MARTINSBURG, WV (Approximately 20 miles) Take Route 9 East to Charles Town; Stay on Route 9 By-pass and exit onto Route 17 (Flowing Springs Road toward Shepherdstown); Stay on Route 17 and turn right onto Route 22 (Job Corps Rd.); Entrance to Sam Michael's Park is approximately 2 miles on right.

FROM WINCHESTER, VA (Approximately 30 miles) Take Route 7 to Berryville, VA; At Berryville take Route 340 North to Charles Town (nearer to Charles Town, Route 340 will become the Bypass around Charles Town); Stay on Bypass and exit onto Route 17 (Flowing Springs Road toward Shepherdstown); Stay on Route 17 and turn right onto Route 22 (Job Corps Rd.); Entrance to Sam Michael's Park is approximately 2 miles on right.
